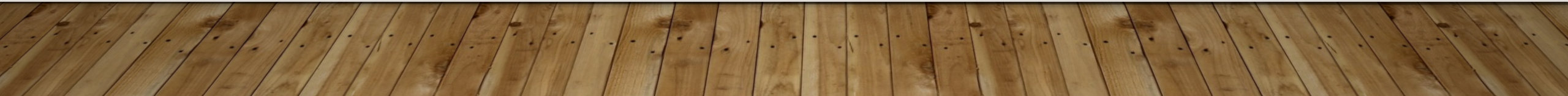

REVISION OF PASSIVE VOICE



SIMPLE PRESENT PASSIVE

- The object is the important thing NOT who does the action
- FORM : Object + **am /is / are** + Verb in Past participle
- Example
- English is spoken everywhere
- Smoking isn't allowed in closed public places

PAST SIMPLE PASSIVE

- Form : Object + **was /were** + Past Participle +(by)
- Example : Television was invented by Baird.
- Television wasn't invented by Edison

PRESENT PERFECT PASSIVE

- Form : Object + Have / Has + **Been** + Past Participle + (by)
- Example:
- Fake photographs **have been posted** online.
- Fake news **haven't been printed** in newspapers

MODAL PASSIVES

- Form : object + modal + **Be** + Past Participle +(by)
- Modals = Will /Must/ Can / Should /Could /Would / May etc.
- Classes wil be taught online .

PASSIVE INFINITIVE

- Form : Object + Main verb + TO BE + Past Participle.
- Main verb = Be (am/is/are) like(likes)
- have (has/have) ask (asks)
- know (Know/knows)
- want (wants) * Remember He /She / It the verb in present must
- need(needs) have S
- expect(expects) Negative Doesn't

-
- I / WE / YOU / THEY the verb in the base form
 - Negative DON'T + verb
 - Examples :The bottle needs to be closed
 - Moser likes to be challenged
 - Moser doesn't need to be explained.
 - I don't need to be told again .You've already told me.

PASSIVE INFINITIVE

- Form : Object + Main verb + TO BE + Past Participle.
- Main verb = Be (was/were) like(liked)
- have (had) ask (asked)
- know (knew)
- want (wanted) * Remember : Negative Didn't + base form
- need(needed)
- expect(expected)

EXAMPLES

- The lamp didn't have to be plugged in
- Moser didn't expect to be known around the world for his invention.
- The test had to be corrected because there was an error .

PASSIVE INFINITIVE WITH MODALS

- Form Object + **Must Be** + Past Participle.
- **Should Be**
- **Had better Be**
- Example : The bottle must be closed with a black top
